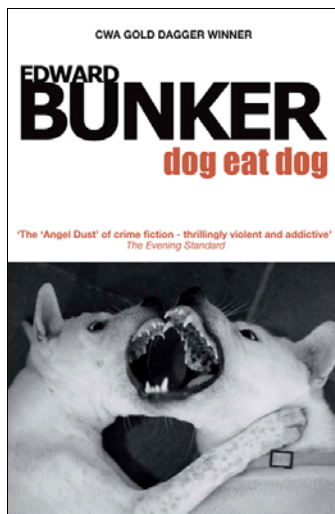

Troy constructs the perfect crime and they pull it off, but in the aftermath, they keep finding the law, surrounding them wherever they go.

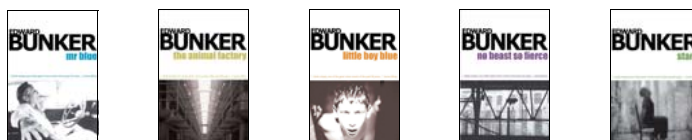
