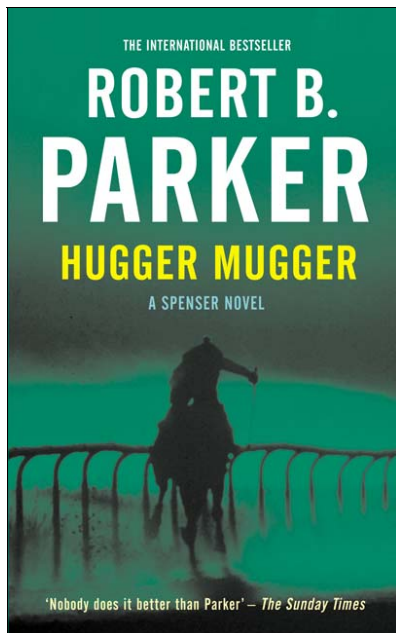

DESCRIPTION:
